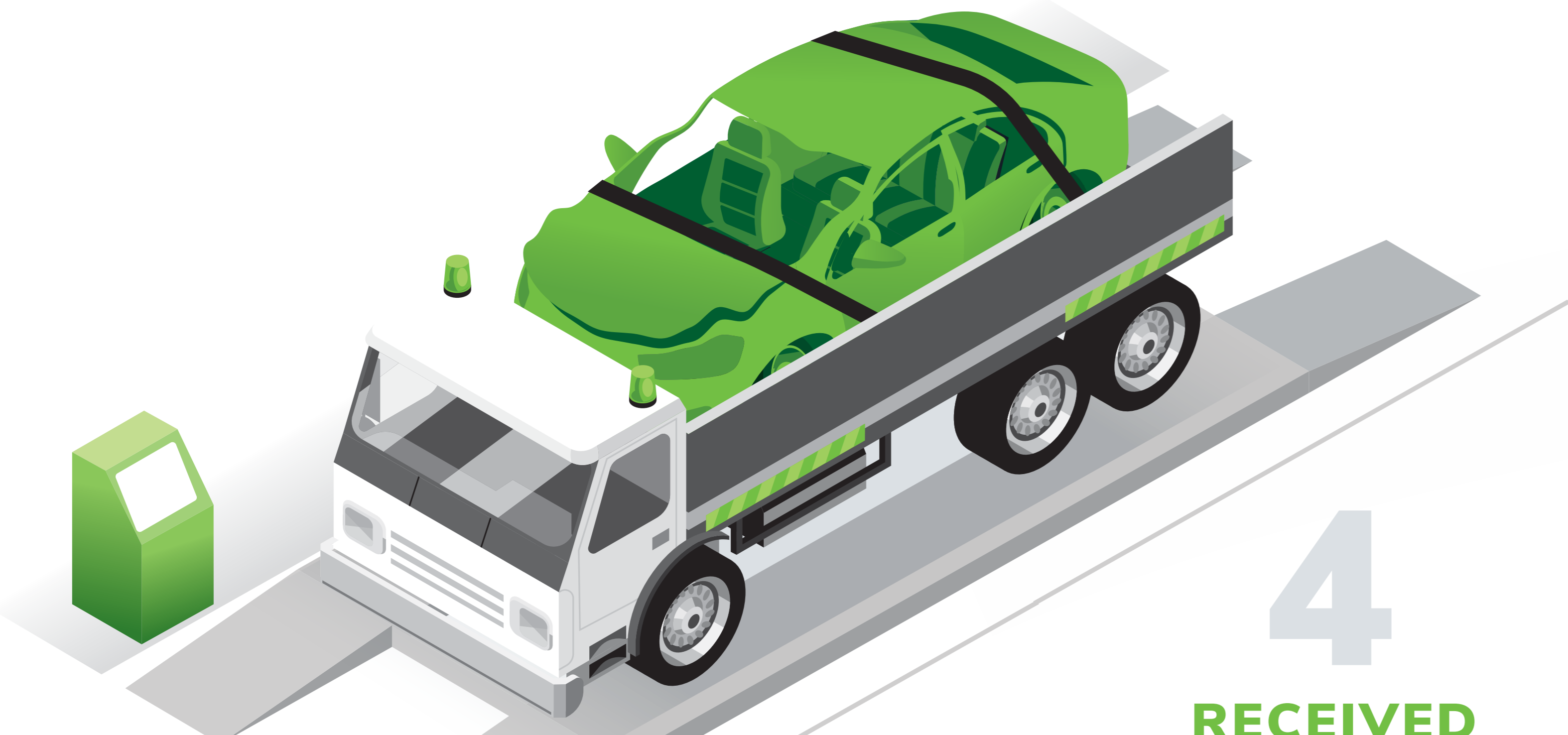


THE ELECTRONIC COVER LETTER (e-bgb)

The electronic cover letter (known as the e-bgb) went live in October 2020. By the end of 2021, 94 ARN-affiliated car-dismantling companies were making active use of the e-bgb.

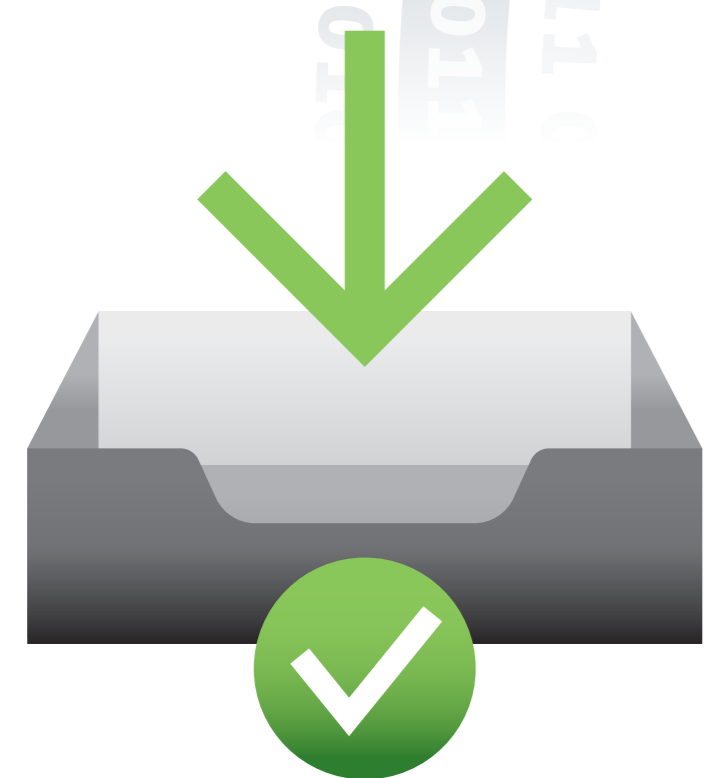

RECEIVED

On arrival at the shredder company or intermediary, the transport is weighed.



The e-bgb is given the status "Received".



AWAITING APPROVAL

The number of end-of-life vehicles and their net weight are entered in the e-bgb, which is then given the status "Awaiting approval".

CREATION

An e-bgb is created before the start of the transport.

FILLING-IN

The number of end-of-life vehicles is filled-in just before departure from the car-dismantling company.

TRANSPORT

Transport to the shredder company or intermediary takes place.



COMPLETED

After approval of the number of end-of-life vehicles by the car-dismantling company (by means of a green thumbs-up), the e-bgb is given the status "Completed".



Every two weeks the completed e-bgbs are processed by ARN. In addition to reporting the recycling performance, the car-dismantling companies are also paid.
